

Release from Liability (Volunteers)

LEGAL NOTICE: All adult volunteers must have a Criminal Background Check and a Sex Offender Background Check performed prior to arrival on campgrounds. Results must be presented upon arrival to the campsite.

I. PARTICIPATION CONSENT I understand and certify that my participation in Sickle Cell Foundation of Georgia, Inc.'s ("SCFG") Camp New Hope and its activities at the Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way is completely voluntary. I have familiarized myself with SCFG's program and activities at Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way in which I will be participating. I recognize that certain hazards and dangers are inherent in these activities, which may include, but not limited to, the activities of horseback riding, high and low elements ropes course, swimming, archery, gardening, cooking, biking, sports, and boating. I acknowledge that although SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way have taken safety measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants and volunteers, SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way cannot insure or guarantee that the participants, equipment, premises or activities will be free of hazards, accidents or injuries. I recognize the importance of knowing and abiding by the rules, regulations, and procedures for SCFG's Camp New Hope at Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way. Further, I have received approval from a doctor authorizing me to participate in the SCFG's Camp New Hope activities at Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way. I also agree to inform SCFG of any activities in which I may not participate.

II. LIABILITY RELEASE I, the undersigned, understand that occasionally accidents occur during camp activities and that participants and volunteers may sustain serious personal injury and property damages as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risks of camp activities, nevertheless, I agree to assume those risks and by signing this liability release, I intend to legally bind myself, my minor children, my heirs, executors, and administrators. I hereby release and forever discharge SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way, and any of their officers, directors, employees, partners, shareholders, board members, servants, agents and assigns from and against all claims, causes of action, damages, losses and/or expenses arising out of or relating to any injury, illness, or loss of any kind, known or unknown, including but not limited to injuries to property or person, to me during or related to my attendance at SCFG's Camp New Hope at Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way.

III. MEDIA RELEASE I give SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way Center the right to interview and/or to take photographs, audio or audio-visual recordings of me to be used in promotional, educational or fundraising materials including, but not limited to videotapes, pamphlets and brochures. I understand my name may be used in connection with these materials. By signing this media release, I intend to legally bind myself, my minor children, my heirs, executors and administrators. SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way shall have the right to use photographs or other images of me in promotion, educational or fund-raising materials. I acknowledge that SCFG or Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way shall have all rights of copyright in and to such photographs and videotapes and may use such copyright fully. I also hereby release SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way and its officers, agents and employees from all liability connected with the taking and use of these materials as is authorized by SCFG and Camp Twin Lakes Will-A-Way. In addition, I waive all rights, interest or claims for payment in connection with any exhibition or release of these materials. This consent is voluntary, and I give it in the interest of public information, education, the furtherance of the goals of these institutions, or other lawful purposes. I acknowledge that I have legal authority to sign this form.

IV. DISPUTES I agree that any dispute concerning, relating, arising out of or referring to the subject matter of this contract shall be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration in Atlanta, Fulton County, Georgia. The arbitration shall be administered by JAMS and conducted before a single arbitrator in accordance with the JAMS Rules. The arbitrator shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability, conscionability, or formation of this contract, including but not limited to any claim that all or any part of this contract is void or violable.
